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






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

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as 'MOU') is made and entered into on this 17 day of May 2019 between the Department of Higher Education,
Government of Madhya Pradesh acting through its Project Director & Commissioner, Department of 2019 between the Department of Higher Education, Higher Education (hereinafter referred to as the 'Department') and Govt Girls P G College, Morar through Principal/Head of Department and, where applicable, (hereinafter referred to as the 'College') affiliated to Jiwaji University, Gwalior.

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# PURPOSE

WHEREAS, Government of Madhya Pradesh (GoMP) plans to expand and improve its higher education institutions with a view to improve the state's higher education system's outcomes to national and international flagship standards. This is being achieved by undertaking a comprehensive and sustained package of reforms and capacity building measures which improve the efficiency and effectiveness of all government Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) operating in the state. At the institutional level, GoMP is targeting both building academic, research and managerial capacity, increasing autonomy in order to better align institutions with local needs, and pursuing excellence of academic departments.

The objective of the Madhya Pradesh Higher Education Quality Improvement Project (MPHEQIP) is to improve student outcomes, especially of disadvantaged groups, in selected higher education institutions and to increase the effectiveness of the higher education system in Madhya Pradesh. The project will focus on the following thematic areas in higher education:

- (a) Excellence and employability through better quality of education services offered, improved teaching-learning resources, and research.
- (b) Expanding equity and access.
- (c) Strengthened sector and institutional governance and financing, and management (including better monitoring and evaluation in the sector).

AND WHEREAS the comprehensive description, implementation and operating conditions for the Project are contained in the document entitled the Project Appraisal Document (PAD), the Financial Management Manual (FMM), the Procurement Manual (PM), and the Environment and Social Management Framework (ESMF).

AND WHEREAS the MPHEQIP comprises three components. Under Window-1 of Component 1, the Colleges has been selected to receive financing, to pursue the goals set out in its Institutional Development Plan (IDP), as approved by the Department.

NOW THEREFORE the parties agree as follows:

## SECTION I

As conditions for receiving a Planned Grant, the College agrees to:

- a) Implement the Institutional Development Plan (IDP) and take all necessary actions to achieve the goals set out in the IDP, including, but not limited to: entering into contracts or agreements for civil works, goods and services (including consulting services and professional development) and managing those contracts or agreements such that to the extent possible they are completed on time, within budget and to the prescribed standards.
- b) Follow the guidelines related to project and procedures prescribed by the Department, Financial Management Manual (FMM), Procurement Manual (PM) and Environment and Social Management Framework (ESMF), and as may be prescribed from time to time by the Department for implementation of the Project.
- c) Refrain from amending the IDP without consulting the Department and obtaining its approval.
- d) Take all necessary actions to achieve the performance indicators/Targets as contained in Annexure I of this MOU and as may be amended with the written agreement of the Department.

- e) Implement all academic and administrative reforms as committed under the Project and contained in the IDP, FMM, PM and the ESMF.
- f) Submit annual work plans and budgets to the Department by the date specified by the Department as long as this MOU remains active.
- g) Submit a financial sustainability plan, covering five years after the close of the Project, to the Department.
- h) Apply for and complete the procedures required for National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) accreditation by the date committed in the IDP.
- i) Apply for reaccreditation and complete the procedures required before the current accreditation lapses, if the College has already been accredited by NAAC.
- j) Enter data into the All India Survey of Higher Education system by 30th September of each year or as the date declared by AISHE, MHRD.
- k) Plan, prepare and apply for the grant of UGC autonomy at the earliest feasible date by which the conditions for autonomy can be met, and as committed to in the IDP. {NA for College, who committed in their IDP}.
- 1) Publish Annual Institutional Reports in the prescribed format given by DHE on or before 30th September of each year.
- m) Carry out monitoring and evaluation and data collection activities as prescribed by the Department and the Management Information System manual/guidelines.
- n) Provide Quarterly Progress Reports/documents and data to the Department, as and when requested, in the agreed format and within stipulated timelines.
- o) Participate in all systems set up by the Department to facilitate the implementation of the Project, such as the IT Portal of Higher Education Department and Students satisfaction surveys.
- p) Facilitate the participation of faculty and all non academic staff and student in training sessions, seminars and conferences planned under the Project.
- q) Establish a computerised accounting system and utilise the standard Chart of Accounts, as specified in the FMM and as notified by the Department.
- r) Commission an annual audit, as specified by the Department and the FMM, by an independent firm of Chartered Accountants and ensure that responses to external audit observations are filed in a timely
- s) Strengthen the institution's governance structures as per guidelines issued by the Department.
- t) Establish a functional placement and career guidance cell and set up alumni tracking systems as per the guidelines prescribed by the Department and system developed for that purpose.
- u) Strengthen the Internal Quality Assurance Cell to enable it to take the lead in addressing all quality related issues in the institution.
- v) Follow the guidelines and processes described in the Financial Management Manual and the Procurement Manual published by the Department.

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w) Comply with the terms and conditions for the release of first and subsequent grants by the Department as described at Section III, including the submission of utilisation certificates to the Department for the release of subsequent grants.

#### SECTION II

The Department of Higher Education, GoMP agrees to:

- a) Sanction and release grants to the College as described in section III subject to the fulfilment of all conditions set forth in this MoU, subject to overall budget provision available in the financial year.
- b) Provide technical assistance to the College for the implementation of the IDP, budgeting and financial management, use of management information systems, monitoring and evaluation activities, help and support for getting NAAC accreditation and other Project related activities from time to time.
- c) Provide guidance on institutional best practices and policies based on the results of studies and assessments of the higher education sector in Madhya Pradesh.
- d) Strengthen state-wide systems, such as the higher education portal and MIS, to facilitate the implementation of the Project.
- e) Facilitate the academic and administrative reforms as committed under the Project and contained in the IDP, FMM, PM and ESMF through appropriate orders, including delegation of academic, administrative and financial powers to the College as and when required.
- f) Carry out the monitoring and evaluation activities and provide feedback to the College through periodic progress reports and meetings.
- g) Apply, in a fair and independent manner, the protocol to determine whether the College's performance is satisfactory as per the performance indicators contained in Annex I, II and III so as to release funds to the college.
- h) Contract, oversee and take responsibility for any major civil works which have been agreed to with the College, ensuring to the extent possible that the works are carried out on time, within the allocated budget, and to the prescribed standards.
- i) Conduct the regular audit and inspection of the progress of the project at College level, as may be prescribed.

#### SECTION III

a) The Department will provide to the College, an initial allocation of up to 20 per cent of the total cost of IDP to begin activities described in the IDP provided that:

The Department has approved the College's IDP. i.

The backlog of CA audits for the last five years has been cleared {or would be cleared in ii. the next six months from the date of signing of this agreement }.

b) Subsequent allocations will be made on the following conditions:

- The College's performance is deemed satisfactory by the Department, using a performance assessment protocol and based on indicators listed in the IDP and Annexure I, II and III of this MoU including third party verification wherever ordered.
- ii. A suitable automated mechanism for reporting will be established using IT Portal of Departments for this purpose. Colleges have to submit their relevant data and information periodically and update the MIS of the college regularly.
- iii. At least 60% of the previously released funds should have been utilised by the college (and utilisation certificates to this effect have been provided to the Department).
- iv. The College follows all guidelines, rules and procedures set out in the FMM, PM, ESMF and the instructions provided by the Department from time to time.
- v. The College has not amended or deviated from the IDP without prior consultation and approval from the Department.
- c) All payments under the Project will be made using the State Treasury System. The College will execute activities as per the IDP and approve/submit for payments, in accordance with agreed procedures indicated in the Financial Management Manual and procurement manuals, to vendors/consultants/contractors etc., who will be paid by the State Treasury.

#### SECTION IV

No amendment in the MOU will be allowed. However, only under exceptional circumstances amendments can be made to the MOU after (a) stating reasonable cause and (b) taking necessary approval from the Project Director & Commissioner Higher Education Department. The amended MOU will come into force only after due approval, and through written agreements signed by the authorized representatives of all Parties to the original MOU.

This MOU will become effective when signed by duly authorized representatives of all parties and shall remain in force until the completion of the activities covered by the MOU, or until it is duly terminated by both the Parties or latest by 31st March, 2023.

## SECTION V

The Department will provide all necessary support to the College through the Project Director cum Commissioner, Department of Higher Education.

#### SECTION VI

The Project implementation schedule:

The Project became effective on date of signing of this MoU and it shall be completed by 31 March 2023.

However, the Department may terminate this MOU any time in case of the non-compliance of the provisions of this MOU by the colleges or non-performance of its obligations as per the IDP targets, guidelines set forth in the PM, FMM and guidelines provided by Department time to time.

PREPERENCE STREET

Both the parties shall endeavor to encourage faculty and staff from both institutes to explore possible areas where instruction can be enriched through an electronic forum between classes. The purpose of the electronic forum would be to connect undergraduate or graduate students in India to students in the Gwalior around a specific course topic, problem, or research project for the purpose of providing students with greater global perspectives on the course content or discipline. #### A report on

"National Workshop"

A one-day National Workshop was held in the college on 27th sep. 2022. The subject of the workshop was "Dropout Cases of Girl Students in Higher Education: Causes and Remedies". It was presided over by Dr. M.R. Kaushal, Additional director, higher education Gwalior Chambal division, Gwalior M.P. The chief guest of the function was Dr. Alok Sharma, Director of Indian Institute of Tourism & Travel Management, Gwalior, while the special guest of the programme was Dr. Shiv Kumar Katiyar, Ex-Pro vice chancellor, Bundelkhand university, Jhansi. Dr. Puncet Bisaria and Dr. Kaushal Tripathi were guests of honour.

The programme was convened by Dr. N.S. Niranjan. As per Indian culture, he invited all the guests to light the lamp of goddess Saraswati to pave the path of workshop. After lightening the lamp of goddess Saraswati, Saraswati Vandana was sung by Dr. Khusboo Jaishwal and her students. As we know that "state" or Guests are gods, with this feeling all the guests were honoured by the principal Dr. Sushila Mahor by offering them flowers. Staff members and students also honoured our guests and other dignitaries sitting on the dice.

After it, Dr. Niranjan invited Dr. S.K. Shrivastava, In-charge of world bank project to focus on the purpose of the project sponsored by Dept. of higher education. Dr. Shrivastava threw light on the purpose of the world bank project. After it, Dr. Niranjan has initiated the topic "Dropout Cases of Girl Students in Higher Education: Causes and Remedies" and said that dropout cases of girls' students have become a harsh reality. There are many reasons of dropout like early marriage, domestic work, security issues and poverty. He invited Dr. S.K. Katiyar to give his opinion on this issue. Dr. Katiyar asserted on safety and security of girl students. He also said that there is not proper awareness of parents for the education. He emphasizes on awareness of parents. Dr. Alok Sharma also gave his view on the topic and said that the world is changing, we can not stay at one place. Without education of women, the development of any society is not possible. The half population is more important because it brings greater responsibility on us. We are supposed to proceed together.

After it, the first technical session was started, Dr. Puneet Bisaria, the keynote addressee shared his views in detail. Dr. Bisaria compared the new education policy with the old one. He said that in the new education policy even after dropout, the value of education is there, because if a student leaves his study after completing one year, he will get a Certificate. Similarly, if he leaves his study after completing two years, he will get Diploma. In the end of third year, he will get the degree. If he continues in the fourth year and gets it completed, he will get the Honors degree. Not only this, a student is free to select his subject from any discipline. Thus, new education policy is based on the choice of the students. NEP - 2020 was made more job oriented. Here, students may feel more freedom. According to him, students have many causes of dropout as - less engagement of parents, security issue, early marriage, gender bias, social threat, high fee structure, less interest of girls in study, approach issues etc. Dr. Bisaria has explained all the issues one by one. He has given remedies also and said if parents are educated then the girl students of such families may have better and greater chances to go ahead. If parents are uneducated, there are more challenges for the girls. He indicated towards acceptability of society. He said that if women are elected as a Panch or ward member or on any other political post, their husbands usually participate in the meetings in place of them, which in not an example of women empowerment. It shows male domination. It is not good, women are free, let them take their own decision. He has said that to reduce diopout in school education, government has introduced,"Right to Education Act". But as far as higher education is concerned. Government must develop facilities in the colleges.

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Dr. M.R. Kaushal, Chairperson of the workshop, said that dropout cases paint a gloomy acture of our society. It means that we need more refinement. Children do what their parents want, so it is the duty of parents to keep attention and to support at every level. So that, the children may feel the touch of their parents. Modern society is going far away from social values. It is only because of less engagement of their parents. With this, the first technical session came to an end.

After lunch, the second technical session was started. It was presided over by Dr. Sushila Mahor, principal of the college. All the guests were on the dice. Dr. Niranjan presented data and said that if there are 100 cases of dropout then, there is 31% dropout due to engagement in domestic activities, 18.4% dropout is due to financial problem, 12% dropout due to disinterestedness, 12.4% dropout due to early marriage and rest of dropout cases are due to gender bias and low expenditure on girl education. This is the data of higher education, definitely we need to work hard on this issue. We must address the issue seriously and try to solve the problem. In this regard NEP-2020 brings a ray of hope. With this, Dr. Kaushal Tripathi, guest of honour was invited to address the issue. Focusing on the topic, he gave an example of his wife and said that having higher education she preferred to be a good mother rather than to be a good earner. Simply it means that she dropped her job only because of her first duty that is the duty of a mother. There are such touching cases also. That may not be a case of dropout, but a case of good motherhood. Dr. Tripathi was a man of mass communication and journalism, so he attracted the attention of the students to make career in mass communication and journalism.

After second technical session panel discussion was started, where all the students and guests participated. Various queries were made by students, that were answered by the concerning guests. They have appreciated the work done in the gallery by the students of drawing and painting. Students have painted the pictures of girls' students who left their studies due to various reasons. Students were happy to participate in the workshop. Few of the students desired to know about admission process in tourism and travel management, which was explained by Dr. Alok Sharma and Dr. C.S. Barua. The questions related to mass communication and journalism were answered by Dr. Kaushal Tripathi. Then the program came in its ending phase.

Valedictory session was started after panel discussion. Here, all the guests shared their views and experiences of this workshop. Students also shared their experiences. Then the convenor invited the chairperson Dr. Sushila Mahor to say something on this occasion. The principal asserted on sincerity, honesty and punctuality of students and staff of the institution. She said that the problem of girls will be solved by girls only. They have to find out their problems and solutions as well. They must not depend on male. Woman of today can do what she wants. She needs only motivation. At last, the convener invited Dr. S.K. Shrivastava to give vote of thanks. He thanked all guests, participants, staff members and those that have assisted directly or indirectly in the workshop. It is with this gratefulness; the function came to an end.
